

5 Reasons Pets Are Returned To Shelters

1. ALLERGIES – Ask about allergy history of adopters, as well as family members. Ask what he/she would do if allergies developed in a family member. What is the adopter's plan if this happens?

Solutions:

frequent vacuuming
frequent pet grooming
air filter system
special medications
dietary adjustments
block off sleeping quarters

- 2. LIFE CHANGES Ask adopters to provide a plan for the animal's future in the event of re-location, divorce or new baby.
- 3. LITTERBOX PROBLEMS/HOUSEBREAKING -

Solutions:

frequent litter cleaning controlled confinement humane training techniques medication animal behavioral counseling

- 4. BEHAVIOR PROBLEMS Cats:
 - scratching furniture
 - jumping on counters
 - eating, digging houseplants

Some Solutions:

- water spray bottle
- scratching post
- spay/neuter

Dogs:

- snapping/nipping
- jumping
- chewing
- scratching the door
- excessive barking

Some Solutions:

- controlled confinement
- fencing
- training
- spay/neuter
- 5. NOT ENOUGH <u>TIME</u> FOR ANIMALS Screening potential adopters is usually the best defense against this problem.
